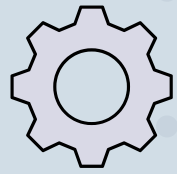
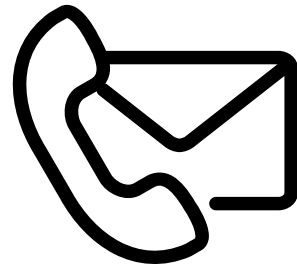

Example script: Principal or Year Level Coordinator

My child has recently been diagnosed with Level 2 Autism and ADHD (in-attentive). The most recent semester report and Naplan results indicate that they are 2 standard deviations behind their peers in most subjects. I would like to meet with you to discuss my child's learning needs and an Individual Education Plan (IEP). I would like a Student Support Group meeting to be arranged as soon as possible. Could my child's [OT, speech therapist, psychologist] attend online? They will be able to provide insight about ways we can support specific learning needs. To help you with your planning we are all available at these times.
